**BYLAW NO. 5-2001**


**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WALDHEIM TO REGULATE ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN OF WALDHEIM**

Whereas Provincial Legislation, Section 9 (1) of the *All Terrain Vehicles Act*, enables a Council of a Urban Municipality to permit the operation of any All Terrain Vehicles within the municipality,

And Whereas the Council of the Town of Waldheim deems it appropriate to permit the operation of any All Terrain Vehicles within the municipality,

Therefore the Council of the Town of Waldheim in the Province of Saskatchewan, pursuant to *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* and the *All Terrain Vehicles Act*, enacts as follows:


1. This Bylaw may be cited as the *All Terrain Vehicles Bylaw*.
2. Interpretation:
  - a) "Town" means the Town of Waldheim
  - b) "All Terrain Vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle that meets all of the necessary requirements of Section 2 (1)(b) of the *All Terrain Vehicles Act*.
3. Pursuant to Section 9 (2) of the *All Terrain Vehicles Act* the Town will permit the operation of All Terrain Vehicles within the municipality on "*Crown owned Street and Alley right-of-ways only.*"
4. The person or operator of an All Terrain Vehicle shall operate the All Terrain Vehicle within the boundaries of the Town of Waldheim in accordance with and pursuant to the *All Terrain Vehicles Act*.
5. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and is liable to a fine or imprisonment pursuant to Section 32 of the *All Terrain Vehicles Act*.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the third reading and adoption.
