**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WALDHEIM TO CONTROL
THE OWNERSHIP OF ANIMALS**


The Council of the TOWN of WALDHEIM in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referenced as "The Animal Ownership Bylaw".
2. The purpose of the Bylaw is to control and regulate cats and dogs;
3. Limits – Cats and Dogs
 - a. No person within the Town shall harbour or keep more than two (2) adult dogs and two (2) adult cats on any one property. If an owner fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of this section, he/she shall be subject to the penalties as set out in Section 4.
4. Penalty
 - a. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to a fine of \$100.00 for the first offence and \$500.00 for any subsequent offence.
 - b. All infractions after the first and subsequent offences are to be rectified within 30 days.


